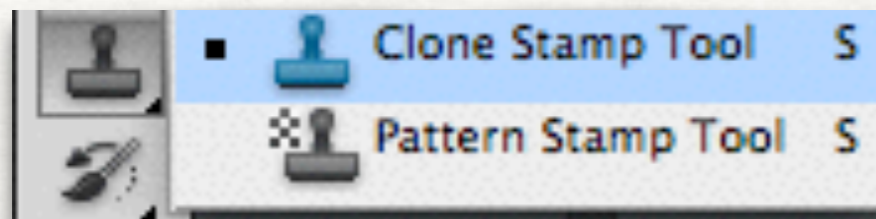

PHOTO RESTORATION

- You will be using the CLONE STAMP tool to “repair” a damaged photograph into a crisp & clean image

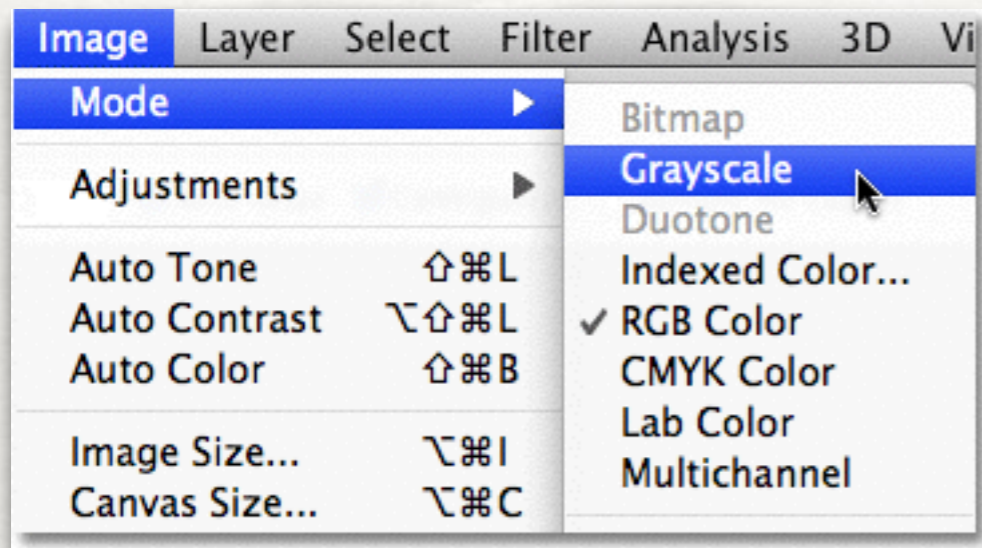


SETTING UP YOUR FILE

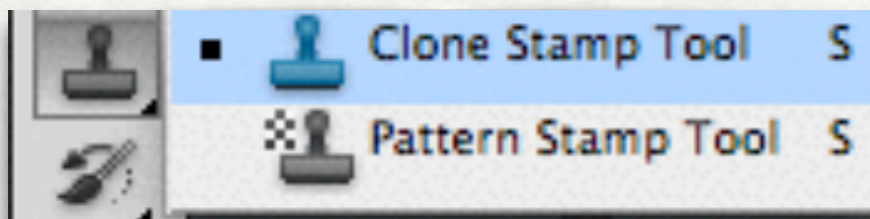
1. OPEN IMAGE IN PHOTOSHOP

- Go on the website, and choose & download a photo to repair

2. CONVERT TO GRAYSCALE



3. SELECT CLONE STAMP TOOL (ON LEFT SIDE TOOL BAR)



COPYING & PASTING

1. PRESS & HOLD THE "OPTION" KEY

- A little crosshair symbol should appear
- This will let you select an area that you would like to copy

2. CLICK ON THE AREA THAT YOU WANT TO COPY

- Find an area you would like to patch up. It's a good idea to select & copy from a nearby surrounding area that is similar in texture and value

*TO ZOOM IN, PRESS

COPYING & PASTING

3. PASTE

- Use your cursor like a paintbrush to paste your selected area over the damaged area
- Work in **SMALL SECTIONS** at a time!
- Re-select your target area often, and feel free to adjust your brush size

BLENDING

SPOT HEALING BRUSH TOOL

- Use this tool to blend your pasted area into your image. This will get rid of any obvious, harsh edges
